Purpose:

The Mid-Hudson Chapter of the NYS Association of School Business Officials is offering four (4) five-hundred dollar (\$500) scholarship awards to graduating students from school districts in Orange, Ulster, Sullivan, or Dutchess County who are pursuing a degree in Business, Finance and/or Education.

<u>Eligibility:</u>

Applicants will be:

- Graduating students in good academic standing planning a post secondary course study in the field of business, finance, and/or education.
- Selected from the graduating class of a Mid-Hudson ASBO member district whose School Business Official is a member in good standing and actively employed by said district. Dues must be paid in full for the current school year.

Application Procedures:

The application form must be completed and submitted along with

- 1. Three letters of reference
- 2. Official high school transcript
- 3. One-page narrative explaining their reasons for applying for the scholarship and their goals in the field of business, finance and/or education.

Completed applications are to be (e)mailed (and postmarked) or emailed by Friday, February 28, 2025.

Decision:

Upon completion of the review process by the Scholarship Committee, all applicants will be notified of the award decision no later than May 2. The winning student and two members of their family, along with the member district business official will be honored at the meeting of the Mid-Hudson Chapter of NYSASBO at our May 2025 meeting.

The decision of the Scholarship Committee is final.
