CCSD Online Translation Policy

- Use the book/class notes as main resources (dictionary in back of book)
- Automatic Translation \neq knowing a language
- Plagiarism
- Not accurate (doesn't take into account context)
- Gives words/expressions/verb tenses we have not learned yet; leads to not understanding the work being handing in.

CCSD Online Translation Policy

- **Consequences for translator abuse:**
 - **First time:** Warning. No credit for the online translated part of the assignment. You will be allowed to redo the sentences for credit at teacher's discretion.
 - **Second time:** Teacher completes a referral citing academic dishonesty and gives it to administration. Teacher notifies parent.
 - **Third time:** Severe consequence to be determined by the teacher and administration. Parent notified again.

Google Classroom Assignments

- All directions will be posted with the assignment in Google Classroom
- Some of the platforms we will be using are:
 - **Flipgrid** (record short videos to practice speaking)
 - **edPuzzle** (watch videos and answer questions to assess comprehension)
 - **Conjuguemos** (vocab and grammar games)
- Students sign into all platforms with their school Google account

Google Classroom Assignments

- All - All Assignments in Classroom
- Assigned - has not been completed or turned in
- Returned - teacher has looked at it
 - It may or may not have a grade attached to it
- Missing - due date has passed!
 - Still complete the assignment for partial credit

Grading Policy

Homework Policy

- ▣ Homework will be assigned almost every day and checked on the day when it is due.
- ▣ There is no make up homework unless the student was absent.
- ▣ Homework is posted on GC daily.
- ▣ Two homework assignments per quarter are allowed to be missed. After that, 10 points will be subtracted from homework grade of 100 for each homework missed.
- ▣ The lowest grade will be dropped if all homework is done.

SAMPLE OF WEEKLY ACTIVITIES

1. On Mondays, I will post recorded lessons with instructions and a quick exit ticket to check for completion.
2. The rest of the week we will practice in class. Students in class will do the same practice as those at home. If there are any questions or problems for students at home, they will discuss the following day when they are in class. I can also be reached by email at any time.
3. Quizzes, tests and other graded practice will be done in class and online, depending on the assignment.
